**ORDER GRANTING THE SDR'S MOTION TO APPROVE CLASS 2 CLAIMS AND TO  
AUTHORIZE DISTRIBUTIONS TO HOLDERS OF APPROVED CLASS 2 CLAIMS**

On this day came to be heard the THE SDR'S MOTION TO APPROVE CLASS 2 CLAIMS AND TO AUTHORIZE DISTRIBUTIONS TO HOLDERS OF APPROVED CLASS 2 CLAIMS filed by Jean Johnson, Special Deputy Receiver ("Texas SDR") of Universal HMO of Texas, Inc., (hereinafter collectively referred to as "Universal Texas"). This Court has jurisdiction over the subject matter of this Motion under TEX. INS. CODE Chapter 443.

1. The *Order of Reference to Master* ("Order of Reference") entered by this Court on May 22, 2013, provides under Section III that the subject matter of this Motion is referred to the Special Master appointed in this proceeding;
2. The Motion was submitted to the Special Master in accordance with the Order of Reference;
4. Notice of the Motion was provided in accordance with TEX. INS. CODE §443.007(d) and the Order of Reference, and no objections to the Motion were filed;
5. The Special Master issued a recommendation that the Motion should be granted pursuant to Rule 171 of the Texas Rules of Civil Procedure; and
6. The recommendation of the Special Master should be confirmed, and the Motion should be granted in all respects.

*Order Granting the SDR's MOTION TO APPROVE CLASS 2 CLAIMS AND TO AUTHORIZE DISTRIBUTIONS TO HOLDERS OF APPROVED CLASS 2 CLAIMS*

**It is therefore ORDERED, ADJUDGED, and DECREED that:**

1. The Motion is GRANTED in all respects;
2. The Court approves the proofs of claims at Class 2 priority as set forth on Exhibit "A-2" to the Affidavit of Jean Johnson". The Court further authorizes the Texas SDR to make distributions of one hundred percent of the approved principal amount of those approved proofs of claims. The Texas SDR may condition such distributions upon the following:
  - a. Each approved claimant should provide a current W-9 form as a condition of payment. ; and
  - b. When a claimant assigns a proof of claim expressly or by operation of law, the SDR may require such affidavits and documentation as the SDR determines are reasonably required prior to making any distribution to an assignee or successor-in-interest.

The SDR is empowered to take such steps as the SDR deems reasonably necessary to accomplish the distributions authorized by this Order.
